Recognition of Visitors/Public Input:

1. John Luther reviewed warrant with Selectmen. JL noted Carolynn Barth would be stepping down as an election worker and there was consensus a letter of appreciation is in order. There was discussion about inviting volunteers for a committee to study AVFR becoming a Town department at the end of Town Meeting under Article 11.

Highway Department Report:

- 1. Work update/plan: Ed Babneau described recent winter weather maintenance and equipment repairs.
- 2. EB noted heavy use of posted roads. It was noted most is agricultural (maple or forestry) and cannot be denied.
- 3. Spring road posting: Motion FE/JJ to approve, passed.
- 4. Paving RFPs: FE noted the CIP is a Planning Board document and recommended rescinding last meeting's reconsideration of shimming a portion of Charlestown Road noting shimming is listed in the Capital Improvement Plan which was used as a basis for the Selectmen's and Budget Committee's budgets. EB and GE noted shimming was recommended as part of an effort to distribute capital spending further than on a single road annually. JJ was opposed to shimming.
- 5. Bowers Brook Bridge replacement detour: There was consensus to order signs for a local traffic detour over Grout and Lynn Hill Roads. Bridge work is expected to begin in May with actual closure of the existing bridge in July.
